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#### Talk About the Town by Kate Johnson

Happy New Year! I don't know about you, but I am hoping for a more settled year for our City. Here area couple of updates from 2024...

The Shaker Village deal appears to be going through and the City will purchase the dilapidated Clubhouse in January. Unfortunately, Commissioners were not persuaded, even by the Mayor's reasonable alternative to the City spending millions on the unnecessary project. That does not mean advocacy will stop. I believe we still need to be involved in our City government and know what is happening.

Two ordinances that we advocated for that have been approved/improved in 2024 are the

- 1. Overnight Street Parking prohibition and increased Noise Ordinance. The Highlights are as follows: Overnight Street Parking prohibition has been strengthened by adding two overnight code enforcers. This is a time of education, but soon they will be handing out parking tickets. First responders have been unable to get to homes needing assistance in some communities, and the street parking can delay much needed help.
- Tamarac Noise Ordinance: Generally,
   Noise means any sound that is plainly audible from a distance of fifteen (15) feet, or from the property of another.
   Any loud or raucous noise, or
   Any noise that is plainly audible and disturbs, injures, or endangers the comfort, repose,
- 3. health, peace, or safety of reasonable persons of ordinary sensitivity within the jurisdictiona llimits of the city, or

  Any noise that is plainly audible, harsh, prolonged, unnatural, or unusual in time place causing discomfort to any persons within the neighborhood, interfering with the peace and comfort of neighbors or their guests, or detrimentally affecting residences or places of business.

#### **Tips for Considerate Celebrations:**

Inform neighbors in advance if you are hosting a gathering and collaborate to address any concerns. Remember, we all have the right to peaceful enjoyment and safety, so let's all be good neighbors.
