FROM THE BOARD: Tree trimming and green cuttings debris:

For those of you who are trimming for the end of Hurricane season and beyond, please remember the rules of pick up from the City of Tamarac;

"Tree trimmings, branches, lumber, carpeting, and metal poles must be cut into sections not to exceed 4 feet in length and tied in bundles of 40 pounds or less. Residents are limited to no more than 3 cubic yards of bulk trash and yard waste each week; however it is collected **once every week." Questions call Public Services Department at (954) 597-3750.**
